






- Sub-watershed 8 (Sea Cliff) is the top priority

- Restoring Scudder's Pond "should be one of HHPC's priority activities"










DEC Officials on Their Field Investigation of Scudder's Pond



- Remove phragmites and establish native vegetative buffers









Golf course ponds flowing into Upper Pond 01 09 2009 Phragmites at Scudder's Pond shoreline















